# The Imperial Valley Health District Begins Structuring the New Electoral District Maps.

The Board of Directors of the Imperial Valley Healthcare District (IVHD) continues to advance towards the goal of improving healthcare in the Imperial Valley. Recently, the IVHD has contracted with the National Demographic Corporation to establish the new seven electoral districts.

The electoral district maps have been crafted to ensure equitable and unbiased representation on the IVHD Board of Directors. Each district has been designed to have an equal voice in the decision-making process, emphasizing IVHD's commitment to fairness and transparency for the representation of future board members.

"The release of the draft district maps is a significant milestone that shows the IVHD board's unwavering commitment to creating a unified healthcare district for the Imperial Valley. This marks the beginning of a robust and reliable healthcare district that prioritizes the needs of all Imperial Valley residents," said IVHD Board President Katie Burnworth.

IVHD holds its board meetings on the second Thursday of each month. The next meeting is scheduled for 6 p.m., May 9, at the City of El Centro Council Chambers, 1275 Main Street. Gingles, 478 U.S. 30 (1986), and as interpreted in case law regarding enforcement of the federal Voting Rights Act with respect to redistricting. The districting body shall publish on its redistricting web page, at a minimum, the results of its analysis within seven days of completing the analysis or prior to adopting election district boundaries, whichever occurs first.

#### Disclosure:

National Demographics Corporation (NDC), on behalf of Imperial Valley Healthcare District, has analyzed the District's demographics and determined that it is possible to create an election district or districts in which a protected class is sufficiently large and geographically compact to constitute a majority in a single-member district, as set forth in *Thornburg v. Gingles*, 478 U.S. 30 (1986), and as interpreted in case law regarding enforcement of the federal Voting Rights Act with respect to redistricting. NDC used the most recent data on Citizen Voting Age Population data available from the Census Bureau at the time of the analysis: block-group-level data from the 2018-2022 Special Tabulation of the American Community Survey.

If the districting body, consistent with its existing obligations under the federal Voting Rights Act, conducts an analysis to determine whether "racially polarized voting," as defined in case law regarding enforcement of the federal Voting Rights Act, exists in the local jurisdiction, the districting body shall publish on its redistricting web page, at a minimum, a summary of its analysis and findings within seven days of completing the analysis or prior to adopting election district boundaries, whichever occurs first.
